We are dedicated to providing rides to doctors offices, treatment facilities and social service organizations. **Transportation** is offered in handicap accessible vehicles by trained professionals who provided service to over 200 seniors in 2022.



## Provided over 3100 hours of in home service

Light duty housekeeping, running of errands, laundry and meal preparation is offered by our trained **Homemakers** for seniors throughout Washington County to help them continue living healthy and independent lives.

## Over 2900 days of care

Our **Day Center** is known as a home away from home where friendships are formed and caregivers are offered peace of mind while they attend to their own lives. Seniors enjoy fun activities while professional oversight is provided by a trained, dedicated staff.

## Nearly 600 seniors received assistance



O'Neill's **Social Service** experts are on hand during Open Enrollment and throughout the year to provide tools for seniors to make informed decisions and also offers a connection to services and benefits. Care Consultations is a new service.
