This grant will allow us to make low-cost changes to the home environment that is directly related to reducing the risk of falling and improving general safety. Residents of Washington County who meet criteria, including being age 60+ and having low to moderate income levels, are eligible for a variety of tasks that are expected to make the living environment tasks easier, reduce accidents and lengthen the amount of time the resident can continue to live in their primary residence.
